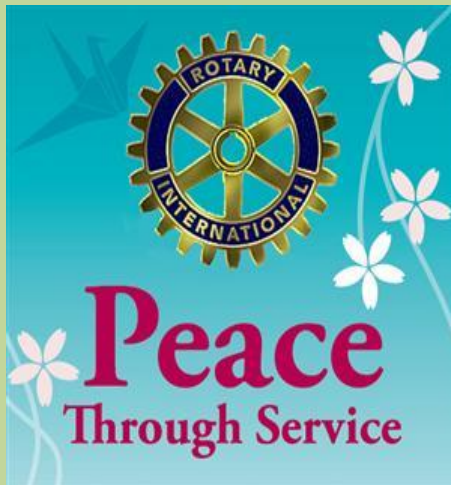

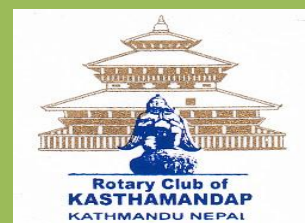

Club Activities



Rtn. Umesh briefed on the income and expenditure for Souvenir publication and installation ceremony and announced the deficit amount for the dinner Rs. 41,000 being sponsored by PP Rtn. Umesh. He requested individual members to lend a hand for the collection of the advertisement payment. He informed as per the policy of RI District, 50 scholarships for deprived needy SLC graduates have been assigned and urged members to recommend if any needy candidates as 10 more scholarship remain. HISAN under the leadership of Rtn. Umesh distributed 4600 scholarships all over Nepal for underprivileged SLC graduate for higher studies. LA School personally admitted with full scholarship a physically disable deprived SLC graduate who secured 87%. The meeting applauds the act of Rtn. Umesh.



PP Rtn. Rajan Raut informed that under TRIFC \$ 600 has been sent to RCK to be provided to Blind program conducted by Dhulikhel Rotract Club. Three MG projects such as Brail MG no. 76682, TRIFC project with US Club of US \$ 14-15 K. Training on Proposal writing was conducted by Rtn. Rajan Raut to Rotract Club Kastamandap.

DG visit is scheduled on August 31, 2012, all members are requested to mark this date and make little more extra time on this day as the meeting may prolong than regular time. Club manual was handed over by President Milan to club Administration director Rt. Martin lama.

Rtn. Wendy thanked PP Rtn. Umesh and PP Rtn. Limbu for providing full scholarship to the talented deserving and underprivileged student Sagar Pandey from Nawalparasi (had lost both legs) to pursue his higher education at LA, amidst appreciation by the President



Rtn. Dr. Pun informed that Lab School paid their pending contribution on MG drinking water project. PP Rtn. Rajan informed that TRIFC current A/c with NMB bank should be converted into savings account.

House decided to contribute Rs. 2,500 (half of the sunshine collected) to Rtr Milan Shrestha, President, Rotract Club of Patan South suffering from blood cancer whose treatment is in Delhi now.

IPP Nirajan briefed on the 11th Installation held on 29th July, at LA School. President thanks all club members for the excellent co-operation extended to him and his team during his tenure as President.

President Milan informed his visit to installation program of RC Pashupati and brought souvenir book to learn good things about other clubs. He further emphasized that the good gesture and work of rotary members has been known to all so the Community service chart has been developed by RI District which will be updated timely. President echoed all member to check their email regularly in order to be versed with club notice, information etc. President Milan reiterated that regular meeting will be closed on time at 9:15 and remaining socializing could be carried forward while having breakfast casually.



PP Rtn. Rajan Raut informed that installation of Kastamandap Rotract was held last week. He also provided the token of appreciation presented to RCK and handed over to the meeting act-president Rtn. Prabhu. PP Umesh raised a very strong point that RCK members have been contributing funds to District and need follow up on its recognition. Every month RCK should conduct Senate meeting to ascertain, generate fund and plan and project so the contribution can be recognized and valued. At this moment, PP Pradeep raised the point that it is high time that RCK should file the candidacy for the post of Governor of District 3292.

PP Rajan Raut informed the meeting that MG for Nepal Orthopedic Hospital, solar backup for ICU is being discussed in collaboration with our sister Club Simodate Japan. Since our club has decided to carry MG with Simodate it was decided upon deliberation that RCK shall consider this project if it gets MG number and may drop Humla Solar Light Project since we cannot do more than 3 MG Project in one fiscal year. The meeting was also informed by the Chair Rtn. Prabhu that Microfinance Project to carried out in collaboration with US Rotary Club has been assigned MG number as well.

The Rotract club was advised to strengthen Interacts of LA School and Ideal Model School. If they need help Rtn. Dr. Pun and Youth Director Rtn. Sushma Sharma should be contacted.

Rtn. Om Rajbhandari briefed about this Canada visit and observation of Multiple Living System (MLS). Chair for the meeting Rtn. Prabhu informed establishment of International Credit Rating Agency (ICRA)

Nepal. PP Gynendra informed the initiation of Canadian ambassador to bring investment in Hydro sector of Nepal. He also requested all to support Miss Nepal Shristhi Shrestha to vote via FaceBook so she will get one title which shall be the first time in the history of Nepal. PP Umesh informed the meeting and his deliberation in Investors Forum and shared his feeling of apathy towards NRB Policy and PP Pradeep voiced the same in line with Rtn. Shrestha.
