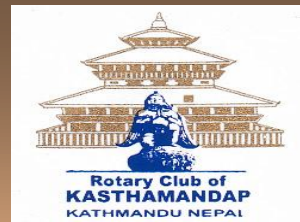

Books donated by CanHelp Nepal from Rtn. Prabha and MNB Bank from PE Upendra were also handed over during the program.
