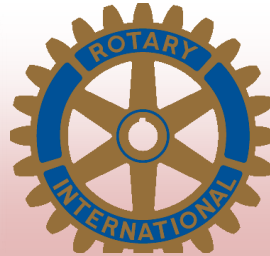
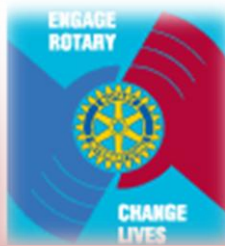

All Rotary clubs are members of the global association Rotary International, which is overseen by an elected RI president and Board of Directors. The RI Board is responsible for establishing policy for Rotary International.

The Rotary Foundation is a charitable organization supported solely by voluntary contributions. Managed by a Board of Trustees and trustee chair, the Foundation provides financial support to help Rotary clubs and districts work together on meaningful, sustainable service.

Rotary's general secretary manages the 800-member Rotary staff who serve Rotarians from RI World Headquarters in Evanston, Illinois, USA, and several international offices. The general secretary is a member of both the RI Board of Directors and The Rotary Foundation Board of Trustees.

Every Rotary club and every district (groups of clubs) selects its own officers and enjoys considerable autonomy within the framework of Rotary's constitution and bylaws.

Club Activities

Oath was conducted by the CP to the incoming President Mr. Upendra Poudel 2013-14. Incoming President administered Oath to the Officers and Directors.

President thanked all the PP and members who attended the Installation ceremony and Charter nite. He thanked PP Umesh for joining the charter night straight from the airport and for the donation of the proceeds collected from the members on the charter night, which was decided to keep it in the trust of RCK. President congratulated Interact Rojina for being elected DIR and wished her success for the coming year and also wished Rtr Amish and Rtr Bikram for a great year.

President briefed on the coming AG visit (July 19th) and the DG visit (July 26th) and requested all the Club chairs and directors to be prepared for the DG visit. President informed the meeting that of a board meeting on Wednesday to approve the Strategic Plan and Programs for the Rotary year 2013-14.

PP Rtn. Gyanendra Lal Pradhan talked about rain harvesting and requested all the members to start it. He requested all the members of RCK to do something for the Darchula flooding. President Rtn. Club Administration committee Chair Rtn. Binod Singh presented Club Administration committee activities, similarly DG called upon Club Committee Chair Rtn. Shankar Pandey to present on Public Relation, Club Service Project Committee Chair Rtn. Om Rajbhandari presented on Service and presentations were followed by Club Committee Chair Rtn. Rajju Malla Dhakal on Membership Development, TRF Club Committee Chair Bhim Udas presented the activities for the Rotary Foundation.



On July 19th, President Rtn. Upendra Poudal welcomed DG Rtn. Dilendra Lal Shrestha, DS Rtn. Manohar and AG Rtn. Bishnu Karkee and requested the DG to conduct Club Assembly. DG convened the Club Assembly and requested all Committee Chairs to present their committee activities for the Rotary year 2013-14. President Rtn. Upendra briefed on the 3 years strategic plan and explained how the club will go in three years. President Rtn. Upendra briefed about the clubs SWOT analysis, which analyzed the achievements and lessons learnt in the past, and challenges and issues at present based on which the club's Vision, Mission, Objectives, Core Values and Strategic Direction for the next 3 years.





The DG congratulated all presenters on the wonderful job. He said that RCK is very effective and vibrant club in all respect and the activities proved that it has membership diversity, wonderful service projects and leadership who are capable of being leaders beyond the club. However he said that there was still some room to improve. Under Administration he suggested that one member visit different clubs every week and he emphasized on using the member access by going to www.rotary.org. For membership the DG suggested to have guest speakers who could be potential members. DG suggested bringing people from Print media as members, that way the club's service projects would always be highlighted. DG congratulated on the wonderful service project that RCK was involved. He said that Nepal ambulance Service started by Service Project Chair Rtn. Om Rajbhandari was very special and said that he had kept that project under District goal. He also mentioned that Manipal Hospital of Pokhara was ready to run the Nepal Ambulance service. He reminded that Rotary is about Members, Service Projects and Rotary foundation. At the end he informed the assembly that the District Rotary Foundation (DRFC) had approved the \$5,000 from District Designated fund (DDF), and thanked all the chairs and the members and reminded everyone to donate cash rather than gifts. With all the above comment, DG kindly announced the closer of Club Assembly and handed over the meeting to President Rtn. Upendra.

President thanked all the club chair for the presentation. PP Rtn. Rajan raised an issue for global grant projects that RCK is involved. The meeting decided to request the district for contribution for the following global grant projects:

Safe drinking water project

President Upendra reminded all those members who had not paid their dues to pay their dues before the DG visit Rtn. Pushpani gave the vote of thanks to AG, Committee chairs and all the Rotarians.

President welcomed the DG, DS, AG and the visiting Rotarians. President thanked the Club Chairs and Directors for the wonderful presentation. Rtn Prabhu informed the meeting that about Rs. 87,000 was collected from the meeting for the Darchula flood. PP Rtn. Rajan informed the meeting that the relief is channeled through Nepal Red cross, and also requested to use the Dhangadi Rotary club. It was decided that NPR10, 000 collected from the club for the Darchula relief fund would be given to the DG for the Disaster relief fund.

DG raised an issue of Nepal Ambulance service and he said that it was a very special for him and assured that at least 300 Rotarians would be the members.

DG said that the Monthly Bulletin of RCK was a great one and suggested to make it a weekly one so that the members who miss the weekly club meeting would be updated by the bulletin.

DG talked about service above self. He mentioned that there was three reason to join Rotary which include Worldwide fellowship, Opportunity to serve others by engaging Rotary, Self-satisfaction

Raju Malla Dhakal provided vote of thanks to the DG and DS on behalf of RCK. He thanked all the club chairs and directors for the presentation.

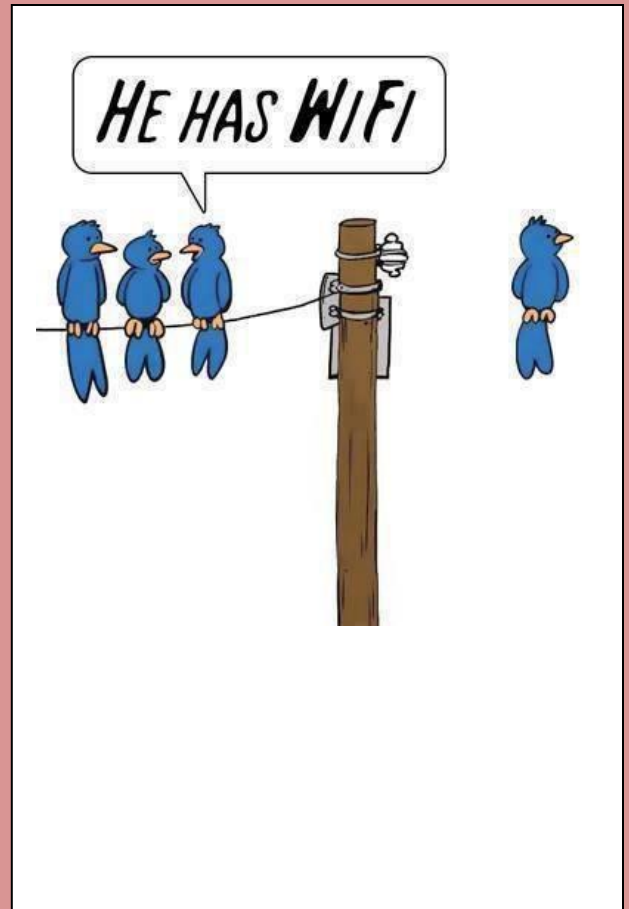
