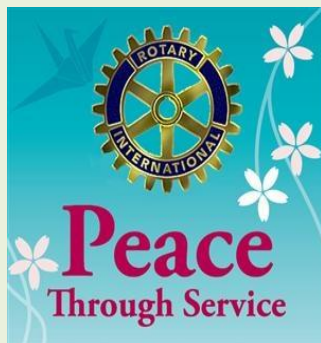

Rotary receives top honors for Future Vision

Rotary has received a silver Edison Award in recognition of the [Future Vision Plan](#), the new grant model that enhances the scope, impact, and sustainability of humanitarian and educational projects funded by The Rotary Foundation.

Since 1987, the Edison Awards have recognized innovative new products, services and business leaders in the United States. The awards symbolize the persistence and excellence personified by Thomas Edison. Winners represent active contributors to the cause of innovation in the world.

RI President Sakuji Tanaka accepted the award during the annual [Edison Awards](#) gala held 25 April in Chicago, the city where Rotary was founded in 1905. The Future Vision Plan received top honors among funding models competing in the Lifestyle and Social Impact category. Nominee ballots were judged by a panel of more than 3,000, including members of seven associations that represent a wide range of industries and disciplines.

“This Edison Award recognizes and validates Rotary’s innovative approach to humanitarian service, as we constantly strive to improve lives and communities by addressing the world’s most

pressing problems,” says Tanaka. “It is a great honor to accept such a prestigious award on behalf of Rotary’s global membership of 1.2 million men and women.”

The Edison Award coincides with the successful completion of a three-year pilot in which 100 Rotary districts in more than 70 countries tested Rotary’s new grant model.

The Future Vision Plan simplifies Rotary’s grant process, and focuses Rotarian service efforts where they will have the greatest impact. The model is innovative in combining Rotary’s volunteer base and a global reach with local resources to support sustainable, high-impact results in communities all over the world. The model funds more than US\$100 million in service projects annually.

The new grant model will be implemented 1 July for Rotary clubs worldwide.

Club Activities

Rtn. Binod briefed the meeting about RI District Assembly which is a mandatory event of District for PE and Secretary. The assembly is about vision and plan of RI district for the coming year 2013-14.

Meeting decided to held Club Assembly on May 17, 2013 at 4 pm sharp at Little Angles School (LA) compound. AG from the District will be present and Chair of club committees need to present the activities carried out by committee, so all respective Club Chairs be present and are requested to make presentation on their respective activities in Club Assembly.

RC Shimodate Japan has agreed to execute Global Grant project worth US \$ 72,500 during RY 2013-14, RCK needs to contribute US \$ 5000. Global grant project shall be used for upgrading Jana Shramik School to High School. The school established in 2013 BS our club has been helping this school under community service project every year. This school has received title of "model government school" by Lalitpur Education Department for doing very good in education and student activities.

PP Pradeep said he is willing to support this project in kind since there shall be construction in School. PP Umesh put forth view that we need to do social service from Rotary in this type of school, but we also need to think before choosing school And suggested RCK to be more open while choosing in future. CP Gajendra expressed that our sister club involved in Global Grant has visited the school and they have certain bonding and decided to upgrade it. He also reminded all members "Life line of a club is Social work and project to Society" and urged all members to come forward to contribute, on this note PP Umesh said it is no point being Rotarian if one do not contribute for social causes. PP Rohini suggested that members to contribute minimum US\$ 50 or above for RCK contribution in this global grant. Meeting endorsed the idea of PP Rohini and decided that each member shall contribute minimum US\$ 50 without ceiling for more. Names of the contributors and their amount shall be read in next meeting.

Meeting decided to held Club Assembly on May 24, 2013 at 8 am at Hotel Radisson, lazimpat.



RCK request all committee chairs to be present and brief the activities carried by their committees. Club assistant Puru is preparing the activities all Chairpersons are requested to contact Puru for this. RC decided to do another matching grant project to provide Vocational Training to spinal injured patients. RCK contribution shall be US \$ 100 for this project. Meeting also decided to make primary contact PP Rajan, secondary contact Rtn. Bijaya, & Rtn. Sanjiv. A bank account shall be opened and NMB for this project and bank account shall be operated by signature of any two of above persons.

A team of Rotary club of Fort Collins, Colorado shall be visiting RCK on May 24 meeting. They will exchange Rotary flag and visit Dhankuta where RCK in coordination with RC of Colorado is building library for deaf and dumb students worth Rs. 12,00,000/-

Flag exchange was carried between RCK and Rotary Club of Fort Collins, Colorado. Rtn. Emily said they are very happy to be in Nepal with their support to RCK Dhankuta School Project. They are privileged to be part of building library to deaf and dumb school, and assured that they will continue support RCK in the social endeavors.

Secretary Elect for the year 2013-14 requested all RCK members to pay their membership due before installation of RCK on June 27, 2013 so the same can be informed and names of existing members can be sent to RI on July 01, 2013. RCK requests all members to cooperate in the matter.

RCK thanked PE Upendra for organizing meeting of Publication Committee in NMB bank and providing delicious lunch.

Following RCK members have pledged following amount to generate RCK contribution on Global Grant Project worth US\$ 72,500 to be carried out with RC Shimodate Japan for upgrading Jana Shramik School to High School.

He suggested few templates to keep the records of the club in modern way so it can be handy, useful and transparent. He requested RCK to come up with their commitment of contribution to RI for next rotary year where RI District 3292 has to raise US\$ 200,000. PE Upendra mentioned to him that RCK has committed US\$ 4000 next year.



President Milan requested AG Dr. Prakash to convene Club Assembly. AG gave back the meeting coordination to President who requested Club Committee Chairs to present the activities of various Committees'. Following Committee presented the activities:

Following the presentation AG Rtn. Dr. Prakash commented on all presentation and suggested there could be only 5 committees to carry on activities of Rotary. Rotary's main focus is on membership, TRF commitment and service. Fund is required for social work, to make service effective, club needs good public relation and to manage all these club requires Administration committee. Also a mentor in a club is necessary and trainer to train new members is also required. And also club needs to remain young. 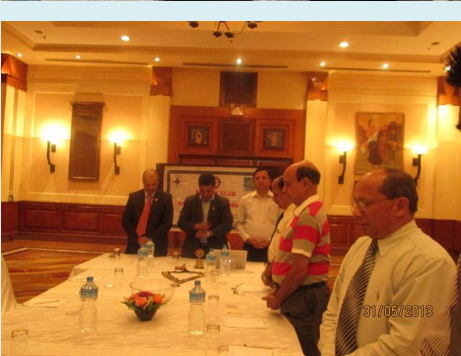

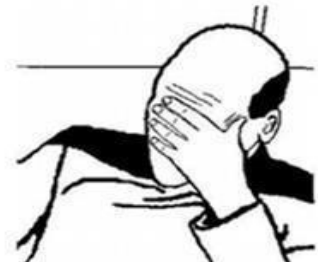
